Behavior and Discipline Guidelines
1st – 2nd grade Mrs. Reim

“And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.” Colossians 3:17

Behavioral expectations:

1. God expects Christian behavior from His children.
2. Be prompt to class, listen, and follow directions.
3. Turn in your best work on time.
4. Be safe, considerate, and respectful of all.

Standard Discipline Consequences:

1. First Time: Name written on the board.
2. Second Time: One check. Loss of recess time.
3. Third Time: Two checks. Loss of more recess time.
4. Fourth Time: Three checks. *Conduct Sheet* is given.**
The parents will be notified in writing with the use of a *Conduct Sheet*. A copy of the *Conduct Sheet* will be given to the Principal. The *Conduct Sheet* must be signed by the parents and returned on the following school day.

Multiple Conduct Sheets within the same school week will be handled as follows:

1. First *Conduct Sheet*: Parents and Principal are notified, as mentioned above.
2. Second *Conduct Sheet*: Student will meet with the Principal. The parents will receive a phone call from the Principal or Teacher. Warning of detention or suspension will be given.
3. Third *Conduct Sheet*: Student will again meet with the Principal. The parents will receive a phone call to inform them of the situation. At this point the student could receive either an immediate detention or suspension.

Note: Students are required to complete all assignments that were missed as a result of detention or suspension.

** Serious behaviors may result in the student receiving a *Conduct Sheet* immediately. This may result from behaviors such as: Physical aggression (hitting, pushing, kicking), inappropriate language (foul, culturally insensitive, abusive), and rebellion.
